



Clicker 5 – using your own photos/symbols

This document explains how to create your own picture library so that your own pictures will automatically be entered into cells when creating grids. For fairly confident Clicker 5 users only.

Creating you library

Find all the photos, pictures or symbols you wish to use, save them all in a common folder on your computer as jpegs. Make sure that the filename of each picture is the same as the word it will be associated with, eg save a picture of the Queen as queen.jpg

Make sure this common folder is stored on your computer or network where all users can access it, for a standalone computer a good place is:

C:\program files\crick software\

Name the folder what you want, eg My Symbols.

Registering the library within Clicker

In Clicker, go into edit mode.

On the editing toolbar click *Pictures* and then *Instant Picture & Library Settings*.

Click *Register New Library*, then click *Next*, highlight *Custom* and put a name in the Name box, click *Next*.

Browse to the folder you created earlier then click *OK* and then *Next*. At the next stage click *Next* again and then *Finish*, you should get a completed message, click *Close*.

In the Picture and Sound Libraries box, make sure your selected library is ticked, click *OK*.

Clicker should now find your pictures automatically when you enter words in to grids.
