



## Clicker 5 – Learning Grids

Making your own grids in Clicker 5 can be time consuming. There are hundreds of ready made grids that can be downloaded for free from the Learning Grids website. Access to the site can be obtained once you have registered with them (for free).

Their grids cover a wide range of curriculum subjects and can be used straight away or modified in the same way you would edit your own grids.

Go to the Learning Grids website – [www.learninggrids.com](http://www.learninggrids.com) – either type the address into your web browser or click on *LearningGrids.com* in the Clicker task bar on the left of the screen.

Click on *UK Site*.

If you need to register, click on '*Click here for free registration*' – otherwise sign in with your username and password.

In the 'Free resources for' box on the left of the screen, click on *Clicker 5*.

In the *search box* in the top right of the screen, put in a search word, eg 'Christmas' and then click the *Search* button.

You will then be presented with a list of relevant grids, together with details of which age range they are suitable for.

Click on the *Download* button – this takes you to a screen with more information.

Click on the *Download* button on this screen and you should be prompted by your browser to either *Open* or *Save* the file. If you wish to use it straight away, click on *Open* – this will open the grid in Clicker. If you click *Save*, a new window will open where you can navigate to the desired location on your computer that you wish to save the file, for use later.

A downloaded grid can be edited in the same way as grids you have made yourself.
