



An Introduction to ChooseIt Maker

ChooseIt Maker is a program that allows users to play 'slide shows' of content, each slide containing a number of different options from which the user has to choose. For example, there may be three or four different pictures accompanied by some text and/or audio prompt. The user then has to choose the correct option by clicking on the correct picture – a correct choice can be rewarded by music or recorded sound.

To make a new activity, simply click on the 'Make new activity' button on the startup screen and follow the instructions as prompted.

To play an activity or edit the user settings, click on the 'Play activity' button at the startup screen. You will then open a screen that allows you to choose which activity to play, or on the left there will be buttons to edit the user settings. These allow you to alter things like screen and text colour, access method (switch, mouse, touchscreen) and screen timings etc. All the settings are fairly self-explanatory and user friendly.

A license is required for each copy of the program that is used, but there is a free player that can be installed from the disc onto as many computers as you like. This just allows you to play presentations, with no edit facilities. It is thus possible to have just one computer to edit activities, and lots more that can play them (for example a home computer).
