Outreach Service

Referral process for swimming for fulltime mainstream pupils

Who can refer?

Your child's physiotherapist can refer, forms are available from the Outreach Service at Thomas Wolsey School and are available on the Outreach website – www.thomaswolseyoutreach.co.uk.

Who can be referred?

Children with a significant physical disability who live in Suffolk.

What happens after the referral form has been sent in.

You will receive a response within two weeks of the referral. You will be told if there is a place available and if not when one may be offered.

How long can a child attend a session for?

As there is a high demand for places, children will initially have a **two-term** placement.

Who will support my child in the water?

Children will need to be supported by a member of staff from their mainstream school or a parent / carer.

Thomas Wolsey School are unable to provide help changing / drying children. We have excellent changing facilities, with plinths and hoists if needed.

Do I need to bring anything?

- Swimming costume
- Towel
- Swimming nappy if needed
- No floats or inflatable's are needed as they are provided.

Will there be a charge for this service?

There is a charge of £7.50 per session, this will need to be discussed with the child's mainstream school.
